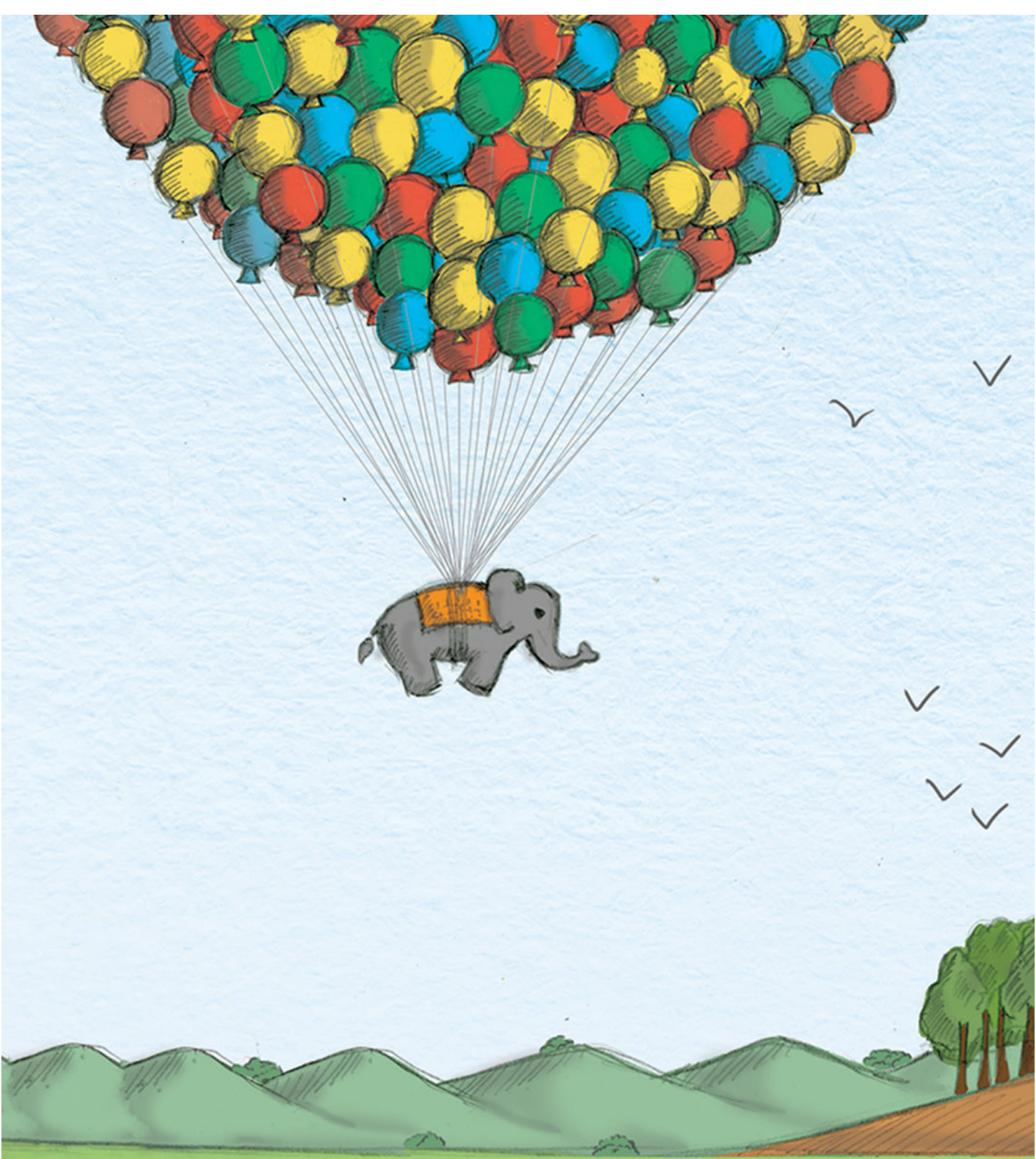
My Amma tells me

a king with a long beard.

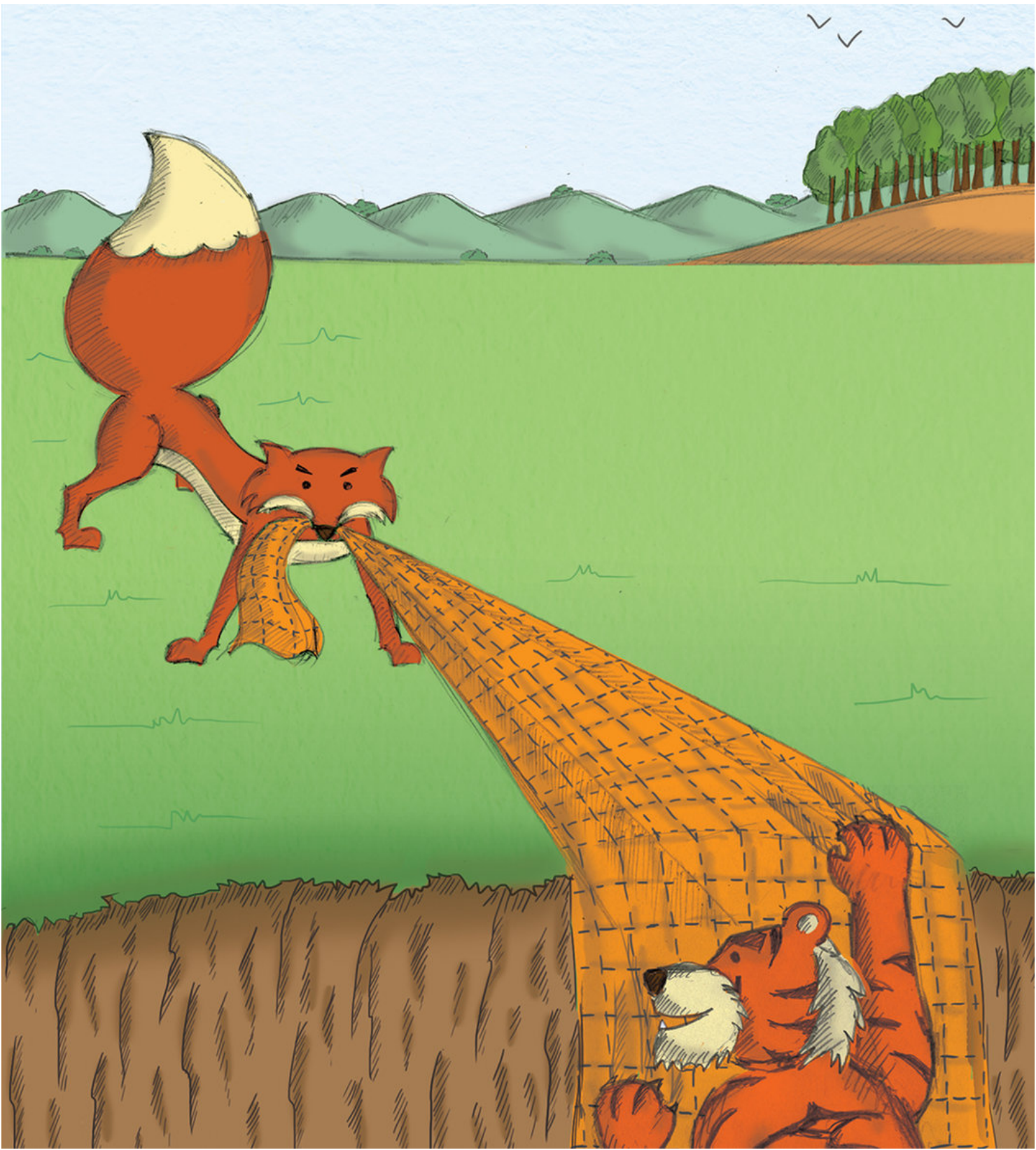


Sometimes it is about

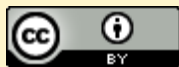
